

Constitution and By-Laws Change

Article VIII: BY-LAWS

The Council of Delegates may adopt such By-Laws as may be necessary for the proper conduct of the affairs of this Federation. Such By-Laws may be adopted, added to, amended or repealed, by a majority vote of those members of the Council of Delegates present at any regularly convened meeting, provided notice of the proposed change in the By-Laws has been presented to the Delegates, in published form, at least ten (10) calendar days preceding the meeting at which such action to be taken.

The section would then read:

Article VIII: BY-LAWS

*The Council of Delegates may adopt such By-Laws as may be necessary for the proper conduct of the affairs of this Federation. Such By-Laws may be adopted, added to, amended or repealed, by a majority vote of those members of the Council of Delegates present at any regularly convened meeting, provided notice of the proposed change in the By-Laws has been presented to the Delegates, in published form, at least ten (10) calendar days preceding the meeting at which such action to be taken. **“Voting and meetings delineated in the Buffalo Teachers Federation Constitution and By-Laws may be conducted electronically”.***
