Helping Families and Children in America, Inc., along with our partner, The Buffalo Teachers Federation, is excited to recognize and highlight educational innovation, student learning, the rewards of teaching, strategies to increase academic success, culturally and linguistically responsive teaching and narrowing the achievement gap among a range of students.

On Saturday, October 17, 2020, we will take this opportunity to "Celebrate all Teachers" from the Buffalo Public Schools. One BTF member from each of the 75 schools will be honored as Teacher of the Year, 2020-2021. Our Theme is: "Celebrating S/Heroes in Education" Teachers Appreciation and Recognition Awards Black-Tie Gala.

Further, our efforts are to attract public attention to the positive aspects of our teachers who work tirelessly in our educational system. This celebration, in retrospect, is to honor our "Unsung S/Heroes".

The program's goals are:

- To identify and honor exemplary and highly qualified teachers throughout the Buffalo Public Schools only.
- To make the application process accessible to all teachers in the Buffalo Public Schools only. (including non-classroom teachers and teachers on special assignment).
- To encourage the participation of teachers in the Buffalo Public Schools who reflect the rich diversity of their students.
- To select a teacher from each school/site to effectively represent that school/site, to motivate and inspire other educators, and to champion the positive contributions of the teaching profession.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for the "Celebrating S/Heroes in Education" Award, applicants must be fully credentialed and members of the Buffalo Teachers Federation. Applicants must have a minimum of 5 years experience with the Buffalo Public Schools

Applicants must:

- Have completed 5 years of service in the Buffalo Public Schools at the time of submission.
- Have demonstrated leadership and innovation in and outside of the classroom that embodies lifelong learning, (e.g. volunteering, conference presentations, cultural field, etc.).

Selection Process:

Buffalo Public School District Only

All eligible teachers can apply for this award. Teachers must demonstrate exemplary teaching as outlined.

<u>Applications must be submitted on or before the due date specified</u>. Applications received and/or postmarked after the due date will not be accepted.

The selection process will take place in the following phases after all applications have been received:

- Committee Review of all applications
- Buffalo Teachers Federation review of final applicants
- Notification will be announced to selected awardees by June 20th

To evaluate the applications, Helping Families and Children in America, Inc. will convene a selection committee consisting of administrators, representatives from professional organizations, and teachers. Committee members will identify the applicants that best address the characteristics of excellent teaching.

Only one applicant from each school/site will be identified, as determined by committee consensus. Each school/teacher will be notified immediately after the specified completion of the above outlined process.

Selected applicants will meet with the committee to finalize all details and answer any questions or concerns.

Applicants are encouraged to complete their application to demonstrate the following:

- Put the reader in the classroom to visualize the classroom setting.
- Convey depth of content knowledge and how to deliver it creatively and in a differentiated fashion to engage all students.
- Reflect the teacher's personal journey and show the teacher's influence beyond the classroom and into the school community.
- Maintain a student-centered perspective as the applicant weaves in numerous examples of student engagement.

- Inspire through the commitment as a lifelong learner who models dedication to continued learning.
- Focus on building relationships that transform and empower students, parents, and community.
- Reflect the teacher's dedication to the belief that all children can achieve.

Application Deadline:

Application Deadline is April 15, 2020. Applications submitted online should be emailed to minesj.hfca@gmail.com and must be received by 9:00 P.M. on April 15th. Applications sent via U.S. mail must be postmarked by April 15th. Applications can be mailed to Helping Families and Children, 150 Brunswick Blvd., Buffalo, New York 14208.
