Please be aware that we cannot release the name or other personally identifiable information regarding these individuals unless advised by the Erie County Department of Health (ECDOH).

The District has ongoing communication with the ECDOH. **The ECDOH will conduct contact tracing and will reach out to anyone who may have had close contact with the individuals who tested positive.** All individuals contacted are expected to comply with all instructions given by the ECDOH, including any requirement to quarantine for a designated period of time. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of these positive cases.

The District has infectious disease health and safety protocols in place to minimize the spread of the virus and other illnesses. Please refer to the School and District Reopening Plans for more detailed information relative to the contact tracing process and health and safety protocols, including cleaning and disinfection.
